TRAVEL BOOK

DAY 1

Arrival in Tours in the late morning. Check-in in hotel in the city centre of Tours. Lunch on your own expenses.

IN THE AFTERNOON (1.00PM)

Let's go for a first trip to visit :



THE GARDENS OF THE CHATEAU OF VILLANDRY. Like a jewellery box, the fabulous gardens of Villandry surround one of the last great chateaux built on the banks of the Loire during the Renaissance (1536). Walk through one of the most beautiful gardens in France, constructed on three levels.

CHÂTEAU OF USSÉ. It inspired Charles Perrault to write the legend of "Sleeping Beauty". It is the very image of the medieval château, the one of poets and fairy tales.

CHÂTEAU OF LANGEAIS. Built in the middle of the 15th century, this château marks an opening towards the Renaissance while preserving its feudal character: large round towers, battlements with crenels, machicolations and a drawbridge.

LATE AFTERNOON (5.45PM)

Back to Tours. Dinner in the city centre of Tours. Accommodation at the hotel.

DAY 2

Breakfast at the hotel.

IN THE MORNING (9.00AM)

Let's go for a full day tour to discover:

THE CHATEAU OF AMBOISE. Built in the fifteenth and sixteenth centuries on the orders of Charles VIII, Louis XII and Francis I, the Chateau of Amboise was one of the first truly "royal" residences. It is a prestigious example of combined Gothic and Renaissance architecture with Saint Hubert chapel where Leonardo da Vinci rests.

THE CLOS LUCE - PARC LEONARDO DA VINCI in Amboise. Last residence of Leonardo da Vinci. Visit of the castle, its 40 fabulous machines and the landscaped course.

THE CHATEAU OF CHENONCEAU: built in the sixteenth century, one of the purest early French Renaissance style works, constructed on the foundations of an ancient fortified water mill in the river bed itself.
