TRAVEL BOOK

DAY 1

Let's go for a wonderful full-day excursion to discover:

IN THE MORNING

THE CHATEAU OF AMBOISE: built on the orders of Charles VIII, Louis XII and Francis I, the Chateau of Amboise was one of the first truly “royal” residences. It is a prestigious example of combined Gothic and Renaissance architecture.

THE CLOS LUCE - PARC LEONARDO DA VINCI in Amboise: last residence of Leonardo da Vinci. Visit of the castle, its 40 fabulous machines and the landscaped course.

Lunch in Amboise.

IN THE AFTERNOON

THE CHATEAU OF CHAMBORD. More than four centuries after its construction, Chambord still defies the imagination: 156 metres of stone façades, 56-metre-high, and 440 rooms.

THE CHATEAU OF CHENONCEAU: built in the sixteenth century, one of the purest early French Renaissance style works, constructed on the foundations of an ancient fortified water mill in the river bed itself.

LATE AFTERNOON

Back to Tours. Dinner at the restaurant in the city centre of Tours. Accommodation at the hotel.

DAY 2

Breakfast at the hotel.

Let's go for a full-day excursion to discover:

IN THE MORNING

THE CHATEAU of AZAY-LE-RIDEAU. Built in the 16th century on an island in the middle of the river Indre in the most beautiful countryside, this chateau is one of the best examples of Renaissance architecture we have.

THE GARDENS OF THE CHATEAU OF VILLANDRY. Like a jewelery box, the fabulous gardens of Villandry surround one of the last great chateaux built on the banks of the Loire during the Renaissance (1536) and then **THE CHATEAU OF VILLANDRY** the last chateau built on the Loire river edge during the Renaissance period.

Lunch at the restaurant of the Chateau of Villandry.

IN THE AFTERNOON

THE CHATEAU OF USSÉ. The “Sleeping Beauty’s Chateau” inspired Perrault for writing his famous stories and it remains a symbol of the medieval fairytale chateau inhabited by brave lords, beautiful ladies and poets.

THE CHATEAU OF LANGEAIS. Built in the early XVth century, this chateau provides a perfect example of a late mediaeval chateau, with a parapet walk and a drawbridge.
